Why?	<ul> <li>historical change: the sound has dropped out of the word over time but the spelling has not changed: light, hope, knot</li> <li>addition of letters: the letter was added to make the spelling more 'French' or 'Latin': debt, victual, island</li> <li>difficult sound combinations: The sound combination difficult to say: handkerchief, sandwich</li> <li>borrowings: the word was originally borrowed from another language, complete with spelling: champagne, khaki, myrrh</li> </ul>
