SYMBOL	MEANING	EXAMPLE
pc	punctuation	<i>Stress is a problem, <b>it</b> causes several illnesses.</i>
↓	insert something/something missing	<i>Therefore, <b>is</b> necessary to explore the problem.</i>
cap	capitalization	<i>This is a very <b>Effective</b> technique.</i>
vt	verb tense	<i>They <b>bring</b> the patient yesterday.</i>
vf	verb form	<i>We will have time to <b>meeting</b> tomorrow.</i>
sp	spelling	<i>Her regular breakfast consists of <b>coffe</b> and cookies.</i>
sing	use singular	<i>Abortion is linked with <b>importants</b> discussions today.</i>
pl	use plural	<i><b>This</b> people need immediate assistance.</i>
x	unnecessary word(s)	<i>The family should help <b>at</b> the future mother.</i>
wf	word form	<i>Exercise is important for our <b>healthy</b>.</i>
ww	wrong word	<i>I <b>wait</b> that you understand.</i>
wo	word order/rewrite	<i><b>Diets unhealthy</b> are common among students.</i>
?	Unintelligible/something unclear	<i><b>I eat animals that them don't like it.</b></i>
inf	Informal register	<i>The results were <b>great!</b></i>
mu	Made up word	<i>The center has a privileged <b>ubication</b>.</i>
